<b>Please separate and dispose as lightweight packaging waste</b>	<b>Yes please - mixed or clear glass</b>	<b>Yes please - paper or cardboard</b>	<b>Yes please - electric appliances</b>	<b>Yes please - bio-waste</b>	<b>Yes please - hazardous waste</b>	<b>Yes please - bulky waste</b>	<b>Yes please - non-recyclable waste</b>
<p>Plastic sheets, vacuum and deep-freeze packaging for beverages and coffee, rinsed cleaning agent and cosmetics containers, composite materials, such as packaging for tablets, milk and juice, polystyrene packaging</p> <p>Tin cans, food cans, aluminium foil, beverage caps, only completely clean and drip-free paint and varnish cans, empty (gas-free) spray cans</p> <p>Plastic drinks bottles and cans are subject to container deposit legislation (CDL). Please return these to the retailer.</p>	<p>Hollow glass containers like bottles, flacons, food jars, cosmetics bottles, glass ampules...</p> <p>Please carefully separate clear and coloured glass and remove the tops.</p> <p>Ensure that no returnable bottles are included - these should be reused.</p>	<p><b>Paper:</b> newspapers, magazines, brochures, mail shots, notebooks, books, writing paper, catalogues, window envelopes, uncoated and clean paper</p> <p><b>Cardboard (please fold):</b> boxes, corrugated cardboard, cartons, kraft paper bags</p>	<p>Large electric appliances like washing machines and dishwashers, fridges and freezers, computers and monitors, TVs</p> <p>Small electric appliances e.g. toasters, mobile phones, phones, electric razors, radios, calculators...</p> <p>Energy-saving light bulbs, fluorescent light bulbs, batteries</p>	<p>Fruit and vegetable remains, rotten food and food leftovers, eggshells, coffee grounds and filters, tea leaves and teabags, cut flowers, wood shavings, charcoal and ashes, garden waste</p>	<p>Used oil, batteries, solvents, nitro-cellulose thinner, cosmetics, dyes and paints, mercury, disinfectants, photo chemicals, medicines, acids, alkaline solutions</p> <p>Please put used cooking oil and fats in oil collection.</p>	<p>Household rubbish that won't fit in the non-recyclable rubbish container due to its size/shape, broken furniture, carpets/rugs, sports equipment, skis, prams, scrap wood and scrap iron</p> <p>For undamaged furniture and objects - please ask your local authority about re-use collections.</p>	<p>Waste that cannot be recycled: broken porcelain and ceramics, cigarette stubs, ashes from charcoal stoves, vacuum cleaner bags, toothbrushes, coat hangers, tights, disposable nappies, toiletries, broken toys, light bulbs, MCs/video cassettes</p>
<b>Please do not dispose of as lightweight packaging waste:</b>	<b>No thanks metal</b>	<b>No thanks - paper or cardboard</b>	<b>No thanks - electric appliances</b>	<b>No thanks bio-waste</b>	<b>No thanks - hazardous waste</b>	<b>No thanks bulky waste</b>	<b>No thanks non-recyclable waste</b>
<p>Items that do not count as packaging include: for example, broken children's toys, toothbrushes, clothes hangers, tights, music and video cassettes, CDs, everyday objects made of plastic or metal</p> <p>Aerosol cans and gas cartridges, etc., with residual contents</p> <p>Pots, pans, household scrap metal – scrap metal collection by the municipality should be arranged in this case</p>	<p>Lids, caps, porcelain, earthenware bottles, ceramics, glassware, drinking glasses, bulbs</p> <p>Window panes, mirror glass, wire glass (separate collection sensible)</p>	<p>Deep-freeze packaging (coated), carbon paper, cellophane, wallpapers, paper tissues, drinks packaging</p>	<p>Toy train sets (tracks, carriages) car racing tracks (road) CDs, audio tapes, video tapes, toner cartridges, greetings cards (with sound)</p>	<p>Artificial cat litter, vacuum cleaner bags, disposable nappies, cigarette stubs, hazardous waste, non-recyclable waste, ashes from coal-burning stoves, all packaging</p>	<p>Scraped clean, drip-free and rinsed out empty dye, paint, cleaning product containers etc., count as packaging and must be disposed of accordingly.</p>	<p>Non-recyclable waste, rubble, hazardous waste, cardboard packaging, electronic appliances, oil radiators and fridges/ freezers are collected separately in all areas.</p>	<p>Waste that can be recycled! This includes waste items like wearable clothes and shoes, all packaging and bio-waste and electric appliances and hazardous waste.</p>
